

## **Meeting with Broughton & District club**

7<sup>th</sup> November 2016 @ 8.30

Pat Hastings, Nigel Parkinson & Karen Galloway PC's (Karen is also on the BDC's executive) met with 5 members of the BDC committee

PH outlined the results of the research to date for the NP and highlighted the rationale behind the approach to the club.

The expected usage by the community is in 2 parts, (1) use by youth organisations/pre-school and the (2) use by the community.

The 1st group would need access to a large hall on weekday's evenings and at night and storage facilities: the club "concert" hall is booked regularly with few dates free between now and Christmas

The 2<sup>nd</sup> group would need a smaller group with access to a kitchen: BDC do not have space/capacity for this as the club facilities are (Wilson room/bowls room/main rooms) all in use during the day and at night e.g. bridge 5 days a week.

The only option and this would meet the community (2) need is to build a "Community room" onto the concert hall. This would have the advantage of sharing the kitchens and utilities.

The Executive committee raised questions around paying for a facility (CIL), need for more car parking, size of a room (approx. the width of the current hall) and location.

The Executive committee will report back to their main committee and if BDC wish to pursue this matter they will inform the PC before their meeting in December.
