

- Population changes risen by 1/3rd between 2011 & 2021




ALLOCATED SITES: Proposed for new revised plan

The King George Park car park, renovation and new playground


- Currently 80% complete plans for ITT in September. Car park and play area detailed plans available today.
- Open invite large project. If we wish to suggest local firms need names to make sure they are on "Chest". Fixed price contract, managed by PCC on behalf of BPC. Agree contractor November.
- Then need further technical reports for PP and consultation with Sports England & council and sign off by Fields in Trust (FiT)
- PP new year with a view to start in April and complete in 14 weeks ... suggest we look for temporary alternate car park.




- Signs available at cottage for people who live on Garstang Road/Woodplumpton Lane/Whittingham Lane to display




Highways: Garstang Road
