- ➤ **Timeline:** PCC to start the rule 16 &17 statutory consults after the 20th May then it can go to the examiner, with a view to a referendum in the winter......
- ➤ **Site allocation** The Wainhomes/Keyfold site including the nursing home and associated "community assets" (scouts hall, community building/new pre-school, primary school field, allotments, park) the UU site (high school) visitors car park and the "Settlement boundaries" as agreed including the "Areas of Separation" will be allocated in the revised plan.

Work in the KGV field.

The path at the south to the guide hut has now been agreed with PCC and will start imminently. Please bear with us during the work as the park entrance by the pinfold will be closed.

PCC is preparing the documents for the larger part of the field improvement scheme. A final meeting in June will agree them so they can go the various statutory bodies, technical consultants, and suppliers to finalise the details. Hopefully work will start on the scheme later this year. The plans will be available on the 18^{th of} May. The play area will continue to be for 2-12 years, Hippo springy and Teacup rotator will be reused and a new Basket swing, a multi-unit provided, and other items will be included. Other items such as bins & benches will also be included.

United Utilities

United Utilities are continuing with the grounds maintenance of the site and are working to improve the Security of the site and prevent any further incidences of anti-social behaviour. No decision has been made on the site's future for at least the next five years and the planned demolition will not now be taking place.

The current Parish Council Noticeboard is to be replaced as it is leaking and not repairable.

Cil Grants

Requests will be limited to 10K (matched funding required) this financial year as the plans for the park, community building and other projects will be using all the available funds.

Planning

The result of the appeal heard in February for the site within the Area of Separation in front of Bank Hall and adjacent to the war memorial made by HLS: Hollins Strategic Land has been granted planning permission. This site was turned down on several occasion by PCC. The PCC are not challenging the decision.

Parking

The parking in the Village is once again causing problems. The area between the Pinfold and the coop on the Garstang Road and the stretch of Whittingham Lane to the echelon and the stretch of Woodplumpton Lane to Downing Clase do not allow any **parking at any time**. LCC will not permit yellow lines to emphasise this as it is within the Village realm area.

Parking is permitted in the bay by the shops and opposite within the marked are for limited time. The village car park allows up to 4 hours parking. Please help us by parking only in the designated areas and not across driveways and on the pavements. Parking in the pavements causes issues with the underlying utilities.
